



TENANT SUPPORT SERVICE



As an organisation we believe that everyone is entitled to a home. However, we are also aware that some individuals may need extra help and support to maintain their tenancy.

The purpose of this service is to provide support for vulnerable tenants. We can assist individuals to maintain their tenancy by developing their life skills so they can live independently in the community and avoid becoming homeless.

The Tenant Support Service includes:

- Advice on budgeting and handling money
- Support to maintain accommodation
- Support to increase and develop necessary skills to enable individuals to maintain a tenancy
- Support to increase and develop life skills
- Assistance to understand rights and responsibilities
- Guidance and information on employment opportunities, education and training
- Assistance with completing forms and applications, claiming benefits
- Access to appropriate agencies

Individuals eligible for support:

- Tenants with debt problems
- New tenants who need help
- Individuals suffering from health problems
