Cae Catrin are flats & bungalows that are designed for older or disabled people who enjoy independent living.

Flat & Bungalows Facilities:

- ✓ Lounge
- ✓ Kitchen
- ✓ One or two bedrooms
- ✓ Bathroom with a walk-in shower / wet room
- ✓ Gas central heating system
- ✓ Bungalows individual gardens
- ✓ Flats communal gardens

Site Facilities:

- ✓ Supported Housing Service Officer and emergency alarm
- ✓ On-site parking (limited)

Site Activities:

Cae Catrin joins the community hall with their social activities which includes a weekly lunch arranged by Age Cymru. These activities are subject to change and new ideas are always welcomed.

Who is eligible for Sheltered Housing?

You will need to meet one (or more) of the following to be eligible for sheltered housing:

- Age 55 or over
- Disabled

You must also **need** the support service provided by our Supported Housing Officers.

The Supported Housing Service includes:

- Support visits to your home (minimum 45 minutes a week). Available Monday to Friday.
- Assistance available to help manage money and pay bills
- Links and referrals to other agencies, such as; shopping or cleaning service by Age Cymru, Citizens Advice Bureau, Adaptations, Homecare (Social Services) etc
- A Personal Support Plan based on your assessed needs
- Installation of a 24hr emergency alarm system (telephone line must be installed)

PLEASE NOTE: Supported Housing Officers are not able to carry out duties such as shopping, cooking, cleaning and personal care. These are the responsibility of care organisation such as, Age Cymru and Social Service, Homes Care.
